


# Would you like to win a party with OKO?

Three winners will be chosen that have the best answers and photos. They will win one of 3 exclusive OKO prizes:

1 - How old is the oldest gravestone in the Jewish cemetery?

2 - Find 5 foods in Kaufland that are from different countries – You must use pictures of the labelling on the foods as proof of their origin.

4 - Here is Rebev. He works in the kebab house on Komenského. **Which country is he from? What is his surname? Ask him: how do you say “what would you like?” in his mother tongue. Buy yourself a Pepsi, and take your first group picture with him.**

5 - This young Vietnamese lady works in the Vietnamese market also on Komenského. Be really nice to her, but try to find out the following: **What her Vietnamese name is, how long she has been in the Czech Republic for, what the Vietnamese name of her husband is, and how many daughters they have.** Have a look around the market, there are some nice clothes. **And also make sure to find out how to say “how are you?” in Vietnamese from her.**

6 - These are the lovely EVS volunteers for Děčko in Rychnov. From left to right, we have: Cahal, Kristina, Nora, and Paul. You should be able to find them hanging around Poláčkovo nám and the park during Děčko events. You need to find **what each of their nationalities are, and you must also take a picture with at least one of these volunteers.**

7 - Here is one of the workers at the Asia Bistro on Anatola Provazníka. She may be working hard, but have a conversation with her! You will have to figure out: **Her Vietnamese name, and what year the Asia bistro opened.**

8 - This is one of the workers at the Hanoi bistro on Staré nám. His Vietnamese name is Tran Gia Trinh. Don't be shy, ask him **how many years he has been in the Czech Republic for, and how long he lived in Pardubice before he came to Rychnov.** Take a nice group photo with him.

9 - This is the boss of the same Hanoi bistro. He'll be hiding in the back somewhere. Get to know him a little. Ask him **what is his Vietnamese name? How do you say "how much is it?" in Vietnamese, and what his favourite Vietnamese dish is.** You might be a little hungry now, **try to buy his favourite dish. See how it tastes.**

10 - Here are the EVS volunteers for OKO. We have Bradley and Rebekah. Bradley is from England, Rebekah is from Germany. **Find out which cities each of the volunteers are from. How old is Bradley, how old is Rebekah? What colour hair does Rebekah have at the moment? Take a picture of Rebekah's hair colour for proof!**

11 - Here is a monument near the church on Anatola Provaznika - Kaple Promeneni Pane. **What is its origin? Take a victory group photo next to the monument.**


